KANSAS AMATEUR SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION, INC. 2009 ORGANIZATION CODE ARTICLE 100.00

Article 107.13 Region/Deputy State Commissioner Duties:

- a. Serve on the Board of directors, and be in charge of, but not limited to their respective Region. He/she will work directly with the State Commissioner in all areas, and with the State Junior Olympic Commissioner, Umpire-in-Chief, and Player Representative with respect to their position.
- b. Abide by, and enforce the Rules, Regulations, and carry out the Purpose and Programs of the Kansas ASA, and ASA as described in the ASA Rules and Code, and Kansas ASA By-Laws.
- c. Responsible for promoting ASA softball, and the registering of teams and team players, umpires, score keepers and league officials within their Region.
- d. Responsible for the prompt payment of all registration, dues, and entry fees, and monies' due and owed to Kansas ASA.
- e. They will appoint three District Commissioners, one Region Umpire-In-Chief, and such other aides as may be required to assist the Region Commissioner in his/her duties.
- f. Awarding, sanctioning and supervising all tournaments within his/her jurisdiction.
- g. Deputy State/Region Commissioner, and his/her appointees may be removed from his/her position by the State Commissioner for: Failure to carry out his/her duties. Affiliation with a competing softball association. The State Commissioner has final decision as to the definition of a competing association.
